

ABOUT SEMESTER PROGRAM

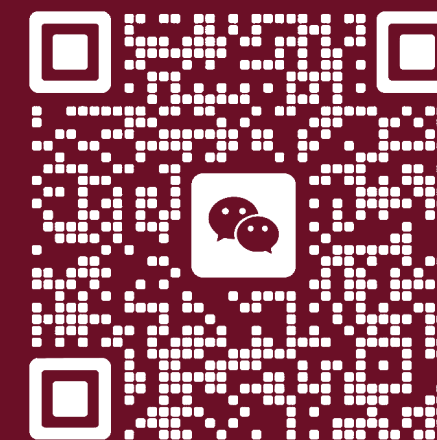
